Bed Bug treatment preparation sheet

- Residents Should Vacuum all furniture and floor surfaces including carpet & hardwood floors, then discard the vacuum bag or dump bag less canister in a sealed container/bag. (Wash bag less canister in hot water and inspect for activity).
- Remove **all** linen from the beds including box spring skirts. These items need to be laundered. Heat from the dryer (above 120 degrees) will kill all life stages of bed bugs. Most residential dryers will kill bed bugs, if you are not sure, take to a laundry mat for laundering. (Do not put them on the back on the bed until after treatment.)
- Break beds down, removing the box spring from the frame.
- Bed bugs will also get into clothing, please launder all clothing and curtains in rooms where bed bugs have been identified.
- All dressers and closets need to be empty so they can be inspected and treated. Books should also be removed from bookshelves.
- All items next to walls should be pulled away by at least 2 feet allowing for the inspection and or treatment of baseboards and carpet edges.
- Resident should remain away from their home for at least 4 hours after treatment and ensure that all pets including birds are also removed from the home.
